

USING EDGE ERASE & BOOK CENTER ERASE

The Edge Erase function allows you to **remove the dark border** and spaces around a document's edge. Potential uses could include: copying manuals, books, ID Cards, anything with a spine or that does not fill the full page. **This feature reduces the amount of black toner used when copying these documents...and that's a good thing!**

Outside Edge Erase

How to use it:

1. Select "EDIT" menu
2. Press "Edge Erase"
3. Adjust the width of the part to be erased then press "OK"
4. Set other copy modes as required then press "START" button on the control panel

Book Center Erase- this feature whitens the center of the copied image when a shadow-like part appears on it

How to use it:

1. Select "EDIT" menu
2. Press "Book Center Erase"
3. Set margin as needed (i.e. width of spine between your pages)
Note: this feature removes any markings within the selected area and creates a white bar down the centre
4. Set other copy modes as required then press "START" button on the control panel
